# What is the UK LLC?

- The UK Longitudinal Linkage Collaboration (UK LLC), established in 2019 for COVID-19 research, now also supports diverse health and social research across the UK.
- The <u>CSS Biobank will partner with the UK</u> <u>LLC</u>, meaning **data will be used:** 
  - Safely
  - Responsibly
  - For public interest research

# **5** Key Promises for Data Handling

- Involve study participants
  - Work to high standards Trusted Research Environment (TRE)
  - does not:
    - hold personal identifiers
    - allow removal of data
    - Not to sell data
    - Always respect relationships

## What will Data Linkage be **Used For?**

Researchers will be able to understand more about:

The short- and long-term effects of COVID-19

All data are **stored securely in a TRE**, ensuring:

How people used health services, and where support was missing

All CSS Biobank data shared with UK LLC is pseudonymised with access

strictly controlled, with projects using this data reviewed and approved

- How people's life situations have affected their health
- How to design public health support that works better for everyone

## Why Combine Data via the UK LLC?

- Brings together **anonymised** data from >20 UK longitudinal studies, including the CSS Biobank, into 1 **secure system**, helping researchers:
  - Study long-term health and wellbeing
  - Link information across systems (e.g. health and education)
  - Answer big questions that no single study could explore alone

# Health records include:

 Records held by your General Practitioner (GP)

- Hospital records
- Mental Health Data
- Cancer Registrations
- Mortality Data

Your **name is never linked** to the information taken from your records

# What Information might the CSS Biobank Collect from **Health Records?**



- and outpatient care
- Details of community care, for a particular illness or for your mental health.

## Your patient health information includes: Details of visits to your doctor,

diagnoses made and any treatments

- Hospital visits; why you were there & what happened, including visits to A&E, being admitted to hospital for inpatient

# Who Can Apply to Use

Only **UK-based researchers** can apply for anonymised, linked data, and they must have:

- Accreditation by the Office for National Statistics (ONS)
- Approval by the UK LLC access panel
- Approval by the CSS Biobank study team
- Research that will benefit the public

Researchers must go through a **strict** approval process by the CSS Biobank data access committee to use unlinked study data.

# **Participant Rights**

#### Participants always have the right to:

- Know how their data is being used
- Ask questions or request changes
- Withdraw from future use of their data at any time

We only **link** participants' <u>CSS Biobank data with health records</u> through the UK LLC if they've given consent when joining the Biobank.

Participants can:

- 1. Withdraw consent to use their CSS Biobank data for health record
- 2. Withdraw from the CSS Biobank all together
